1. **Simon Peter Sumner (Summers)**

Born: @1835 in Illinois (according to 1860 Drew Co. AR census)

Died: Between 1869-1870 (according to court records & his wife's remarriage)

Served in Civil War from Drew Co. Arkansas

Married Elmyra Denton 1854 in Drew Co. Arkansas

Found on one census: 1860 Drew Co. AR

Need previous census, names of parents, place of birth

2. **Peter Alby**

Born about 1794 in Vermont

Died March 1860 (1860 mortality list) in Perry Co. Arkansas

Married: Elizabeth Brazil Fowler between 1827-1828 in AR

Census: 1820 (Indiana), 1830-1850 (AR)

Need to find parents and place of birth

3. **Martha Angeline MNU Alby Vann**

Born about 1842 in South Carolina

Died between 1903 and 1910 in AR

Married: William Alby between 1851-1857 in Perry Co AR

Married: Willis Vann (family legend), only proof- 1 child born about 1882 named Emma Vann, but William and Angeline did not divorce until 1891, with William claiming his wife left him in June of 1887 without cause.

Census: First found on 1870 Perry Co. Ar census married to William Alby & two children. Next on 1880 Perry Co. Ar census with William Alby and two children. Last census: 1900 Hot Spring County AR as Martha Vann, age 51, born SC. We believe this to be our Martha Angeline. Son James is nearby in DeRoche TP, same county, as is daughter Emma Vann, married to John Ashley.

Buried: Mt Carmel Cemetery in Hot Spring County AR

No headstone found, but family members say this is where she was buried.

Need: any census previous to 1870. Death date. Maiden name, parent's names, place of birth, and proof of marriage to Willis Vann. There is one possibility for him, a John Willis Vann lived in Yell County AR in 1880. Would like to find marriage record for Willis and Martha Angeline. But fact remains that she was still married to William at time of Emma Vann's birth.

4. **Mary MNU Hopper Lamb**

Born- January 1830 in South Carolina

Died- After 1910, possibly Howard Co Ar, or Oklahoma

Married- @ 1847 to Charles G. Hopper in South Carolina

Married- between 1870-1880 to Jacob Lamb in possibly Pike Co AR

Children: Ulysis & Martha Hopper

Both girls married to Barrett men in Dyer County Tennessee

Both girls moved to Arkansas by 1880

Census- 1860 York County SC, with husband C.G. Hopper, daug- Martha & Ulysis, and a son named A. Lomas

1870 Presumed to be in Dyer County Tennessee, since both girls married here, but cannot find her. C.G. Hopper died in civil war

1880- Pike County AR with Jacob Lamb

1900- Howard County AR widowed & alone in census

1910- Sevier County AR, widowed & living with dau Ulysis

Barrett & her family

Need: Maiden name, parents names, place of birth, 1870 census, 1850 census (should be with C.G. Hopper at that time) death date, place of death & burial place.

5. **Jacob W. Fulmer**

Born- @1825 Germany

Died- After 1880 AR

Married- 1848 in Union Co. AR to Ann Sofiah Foyil

Married- 1864 in Union Co. AR to Sarah Jane Cate

Married- Unknown to Eliza MNU

Census- 1850 Union Co AR with Sophia, 1860 Union Co AR with wife, 4 children and brother in law Alford Foyil, 1870 - not found, 1880 in Howard County AR with wife Eliza and children. Not found after 1880.

Need- 1870 census, Name of parents, where born, where he died & where he is buried.
