Hamilton, Joseph P. 1795 1884 Pvt. Tenn Militia, War of 1812; Mason; 1987 Census stated that the marker of Joseph P. Hamilton stated he was related to Alexander Hamilton on the \$10 bill" - however, no such monument was found in 2002

Hamilton, Juliann 1796 1878 Wife of Joseph P. Hamilton (grave enclosed in approx. 3' high brick wall with small monument cemeted on top)

Hamilton, Margaret A. 23 Jul 1857 26 Feb 1859 "Her twin born & died 25 Jul 1857" (Note: different birth dates for twins)
