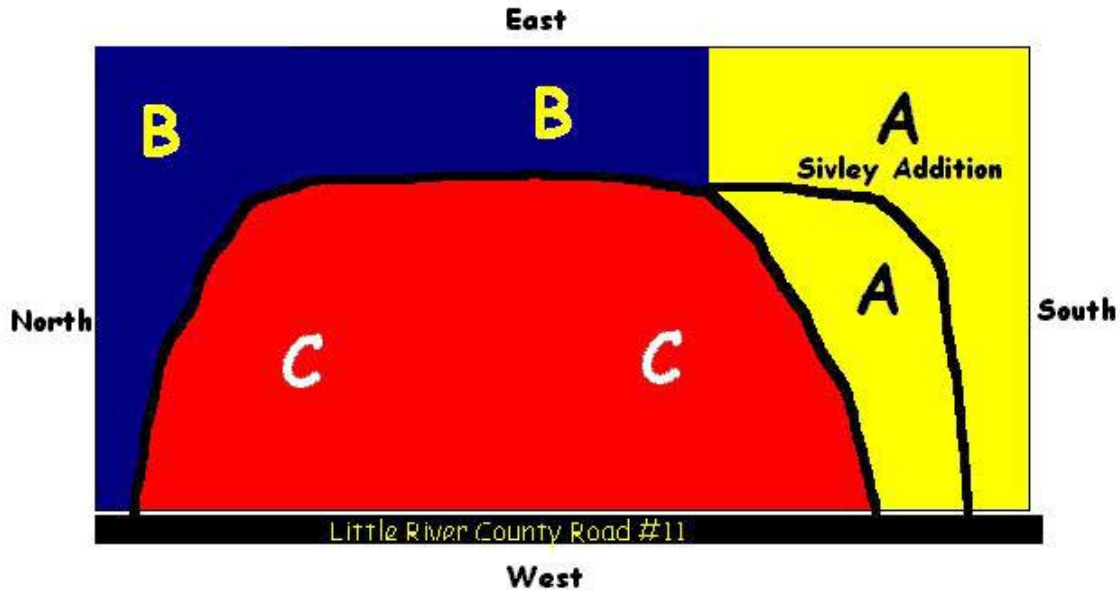
To get to Arden Cemetery from Ashdown, take highway 32 west, drive 9.6 miles till the Arden lateral (Little River County Road #11) and drive 1.45 miles north to the cemetery. Larry L. Cribbs catalogued this cemetery in July 2001. There are 438 marked graves and 35 documented unmarked graves. The earliest legible marked grave is that of Thomas J. Brown who died August 4, 1870, at the age of three years and eleven days. The earliest birthday of an individual buried here is that of Thomas Arden Brown, born May 6, 1823. This cemetery is well groomed and very organized.

The land for the community of Arden and Arden Cemetery were owned by Thomas Arden Brown (1823-1902). Sometime in the 1870's Thomas Arden & Lucy Brown had two baby boys (Thomas & Eddie) who died. The Brown's felt there was no suitable place near to bury their boys so they buried them in their front yard. Sometime after that Thomas Arden Brown told his wife that he was going to step off a plot for a cemetery. Shortly after that the little boys' bodies were moved to what is now Arden Cemetery.

In 1984 the Arden Cemetery Association was formed to create a perpetual care system for the cemetery and to manage the day-to-day affairs of the cemetery. In 1990 the Sivley Addition was added to the Arden Cemetery. The William F. Sivley family donated the southern portion of land to the cemetery. Sometime later William's son, Frank donated more land to that section of the cemetery.

Abbreviations and symbols used: "&" after a listing means that the following listing is on the same marker. WOW = Woodmen of the World, OES = Eastern Star, Mason = Masonic Lodge, TM = Temporary Marker. Any writings in *italics* are historical information, comments or observations of the cataloguer of this cemetery. The letter and numbers in parenthesis following each known gravesite is an effort by the cataloguer to loosely map the location of each known grave and to show the proximity of the graves to each other. The letter represents the section, the next pair of numbers are the row number and the last pair of numbers represent the gravesite in that row. Example: (C11-04) C-Section, Row 11 and Gravesite 4.
