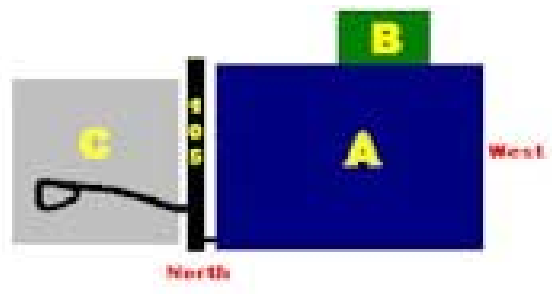
# Blackland Cemetery

## Little River County, Arkansas



**Blackland Cemetery is located west of Foreman, Arkansas, about ¼ mile north of Highway 32 on Little River County Road 105 close to the Oklahoma state line. Mary A. Simpson 1853 – 1884 donated the land for this cemetery. Little River County Genealogy Society member, Larry Cribbs catalogued this cemetery February 2007, and it was re-surveyed by LRCGS Cemetery Committee Chairman Jimmie Wright in October of 2008.**

**Blackland Cemetery is located in a scenic spot among many old oak trees , it is well maintained and in active use. There are 567 confirmed listings.**



**The cemetery was divided into three sections by this cataloguer. A-section is the main and older section of the cemetery. B-section is the small fenced-in Buchanan plot. C-section is the newer addition, which is located across the road.**

**The letter and numbers in brackets after each listing is the cataloguers**

**attempt to roughly map grave locations. A-section example [A05-15] = A section, 5<sup>th</sup> row, 15<sup>th</sup> gravesite in that row. The first row is closest to the road, with each row running south to north. B & C-sections were not listed by individual rows they were recorded by section and the last number only signifies the order in which the cataloguer recorded that particular gravesite.**
