

Oak Hill Cemetery

Little River County, Arkansas



Oak Hill Cemetery is located just off Highway 108 west on LR 45. 108 Highway is just north of Ashdown on Highway 71, take 108 for five miles and LR 45 will be on your right with a sign pointing to the cemetery.

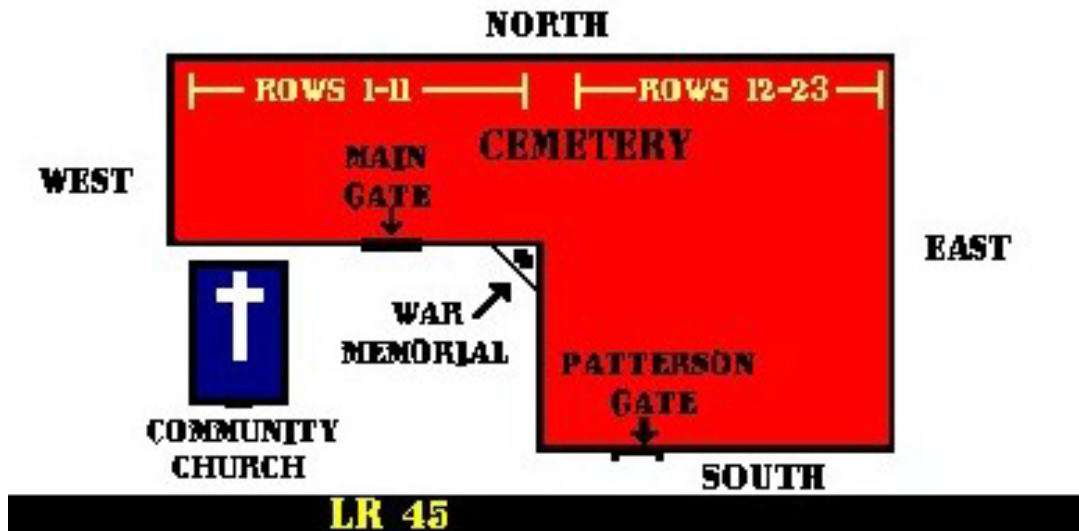
According to the book, Little River County, Arkansas Cemetery Census, Oak Hill Cemetery got its start when two orphan boys who lived with Mr. Elic Bishop died suddenly. Mr. Bishop donated five acres for the boys burial and for a community cemetery.

Of the marked graves, Henry D. Phillips is the earliest burial and he also has the earliest birth date, born 12-15-1815 and died 5-18-1887. There are 441 listings with five of those being unfound markers that were documented from prior records.

This cemetery was catalogued by Little River County Genealogy Society member, Mona Patterson during February 2004.

The number at the end of each listing represents the row number and the order in that row. Example: (05-06) = Row 5 and sixth grave in that row. Abbreviations used: TM = Temporary marker/Funeral Home marker, WOW = Woodmen of the World marker, "&" = means the next listing was on the same marker.
