

Peytonville Cemetery



The small village of Peytonville was settled in the early 1830's. Named after S.W. Peyton, the town included a post office, three stores, several gins, a log school, and a blacksmith. The cemetery is still active. This census was taken in March 2006 by Judy Young and Terri Buster for the Little River County Genealogy Society.
