



# *Hudson Cemetery*

*Little River County, Ashdown, Arkansas*

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**Hudson Cemetery is located two blocks north from Park Avenue on Buck Wright road in Ashdown, Arkansas. I have been told that the cemetery was named after a Mr. Hudson who owned a timber company near this cemetery. The land for the cemetery was donated by Maloy Waddell. There are 154 marked graves, 25 documented unmarked graves and at least 50 undocumented unmarked graves. The first burial of the marked graves is that of Nannie Collins, who died 10-17-1899. The earliest birth date of an individual buried here is that of Martha Holman, born 2-10-1832. This cemetery was catalogued by Larry Cribbs in April 2001.**

**Abbreviations and symbols used: "&" after a listing means that the following listing is on the same marker. WOW = Woodmen of the World, OES = Eastern Star, Mason = Masonic Lodge, TM = Temporary Marker. The numbers in parenthesis after each listing is an attempt by the cataloguer to give the approximate location of each gravesite as it relates to other gravesites. The first number is the row number and the second number is the gravesite number on that row. Example: (20-01) = The first grave in the twentieth row. Any writings in *italics* are historical information, comments or observations of the cataloguer of this cemetery.**
