Unit History

The 755th Adjutant General Company Postal was constituted April 22, 1949 in the Organized Reserve Corps as the 755th Army Postal Unit. Activated May 2, 1949 at Louisville, Mississippi. Inactivated October 1, 1949 at Louisville, Mississippi. Activated October 31, 1949 at Galveston, Texas. Organized Reserve Corps re-designated July 9, 1952 as the Army Reserve. Location changed January 30, 1968 to Texarkana, Texas. Reorganized and re-designated March 15, 1972 as the 755th Adjutant General Detachment. Reorganized and re-designated September 16, 1988 as the 755th Adjutant General Company (Postal). Ordered into active military service January 16, 2003 at Texarkana, Texas; released from active military service January 15, 2004 and reverted to reserve status. Ordered into Active military status January 15, 2004 and reverted to reserve status.
